

12 Clinton-Shopiere-Shopiere Alternate 26.1-21.4 miles 672'-568' Flat to Hilly

Clinton-Shopiere

This route includes moderately steep but long hills as you climb east towards Clinton. The terrain turns to rolling hills about six miles out, where views become picturesque. Clinton is a good destination for morning and mid-day rides, as there are cafés serving breakfast and lunch on Allen Street, in the downtown district. The return ride from Shopiere is very flat and calm.

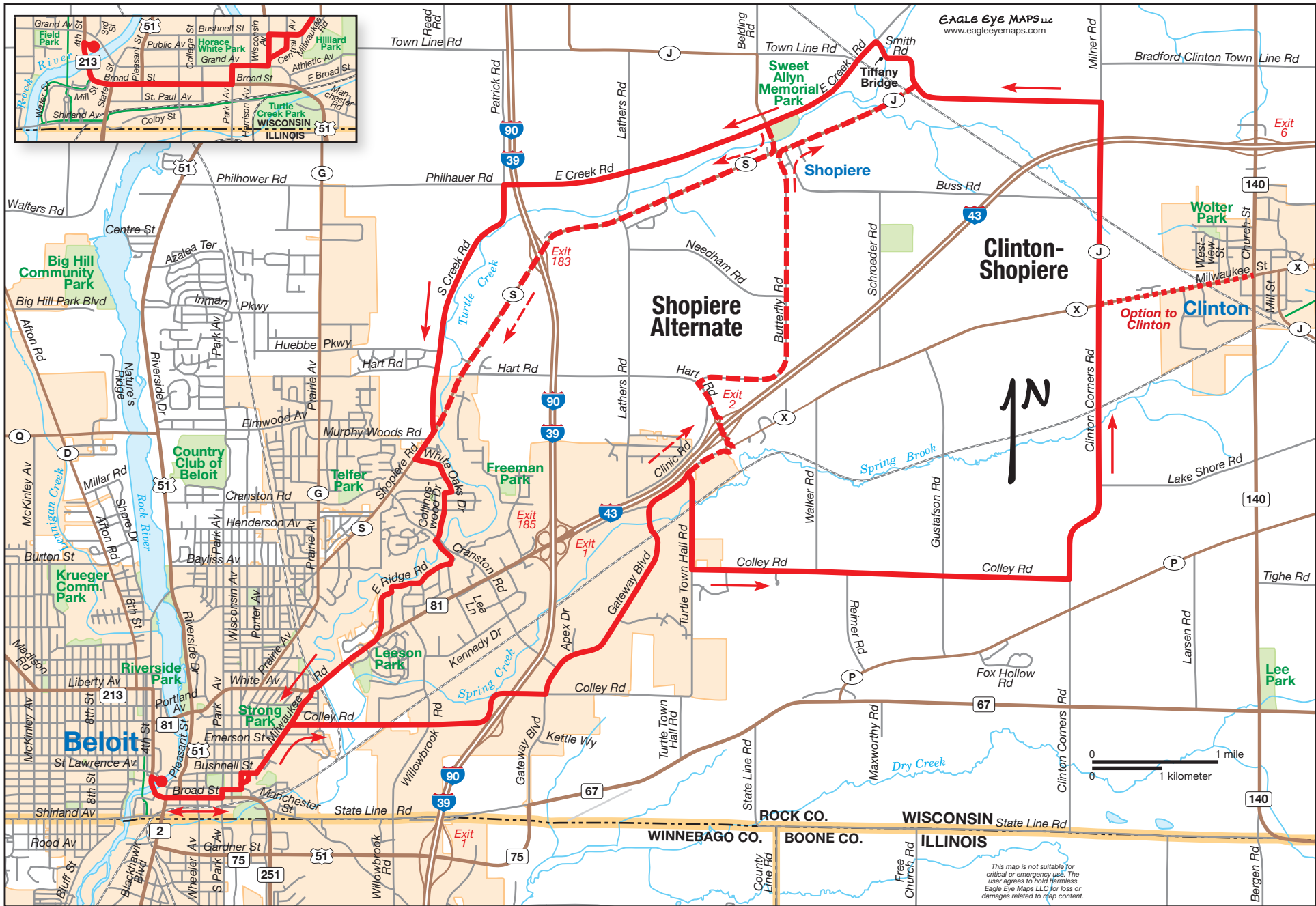
Shopiere Alternate

This route follows the south side of Turtle Creek, before returning on the north side. It passes right through the settlements of Shopiere and Tiffany providing plenty of woods, pastures and cropland to be viewed. There is also a friendly bar and a little café in Shopiere. As you leave Beloit and enter the Industrial Park you will encounter what is called "Gateway Mountain" by many of the local cyclists. Restrooms and water are at Sweet Allyn Park which is in Shopiere where Cty J crosses Turtle Creek. There are many historic bridges to be seen on this path including the famous 1869 Tiffany Bridge, a railroad bridge, which can be viewed from Smith Rd. It is important to note that the bridges crossing Turtle Creek at Lather and Smith Rds have steel grate decks.
